

BARRHEAD FISH & GAME RANGE RULES

1. Members must possess a current Barrhead F&G membership when on range property.
2. Alcohol and drugs, including marijuana, are not allowed on range property.
3. All long gun firing must be from the range provided shooting benches. NO EXCEPTIONS.
4. Firearms are to be unloaded and not handled when there are people downrange.
5. All firearms must use the section of the range for their type of firearm. Shotguns on the rifle range are not allowed except for slug shots.
6. Rimfire rifles are to be used on the rimfire bench next to the handgun station only.
7. EXPLOSIVE targets are not allowed to be used on range property.
8. Firearm usage on the archery range will result in immediate loss of membership.
9. Uncontrolled rapid fire and full automatic fire prohibited on the range.
10. ALL firearms and accessories must comply with the Canadian Firearms Act.
11. All firearms must have the chamber open and empty and the cylinder and/or magazine empty when the firearm is unattended and not in use. Long guns must be placed in the racks provided with their actions open or in their cases when not in use. Handguns must have their actions open and visible when not in use. Safety first. Non compliance will result in loss of range privileges.
12. Range hours-Monday thru Saturday - 8 am to 10 pm or sunset. Sunday 9 am to sunset or 10 o'clock
13. Long gun shooting benches are to be used by TWO different groups if more than one group is on sight. Please share the benches and the table and gun racks. The second bench is for shooting, NOT spare rifle storage.
14. Please keep your firearms pointed downrange at all times.
15. No .50 caliber BMG allowed on the range.
16. Shoot only at paper targets fastened to centre of the backstops or at the metal reactive targets on the long gun range.
17. PLEASE pick up your brass. There are barrels for placing shotgun hulls and general waste.
